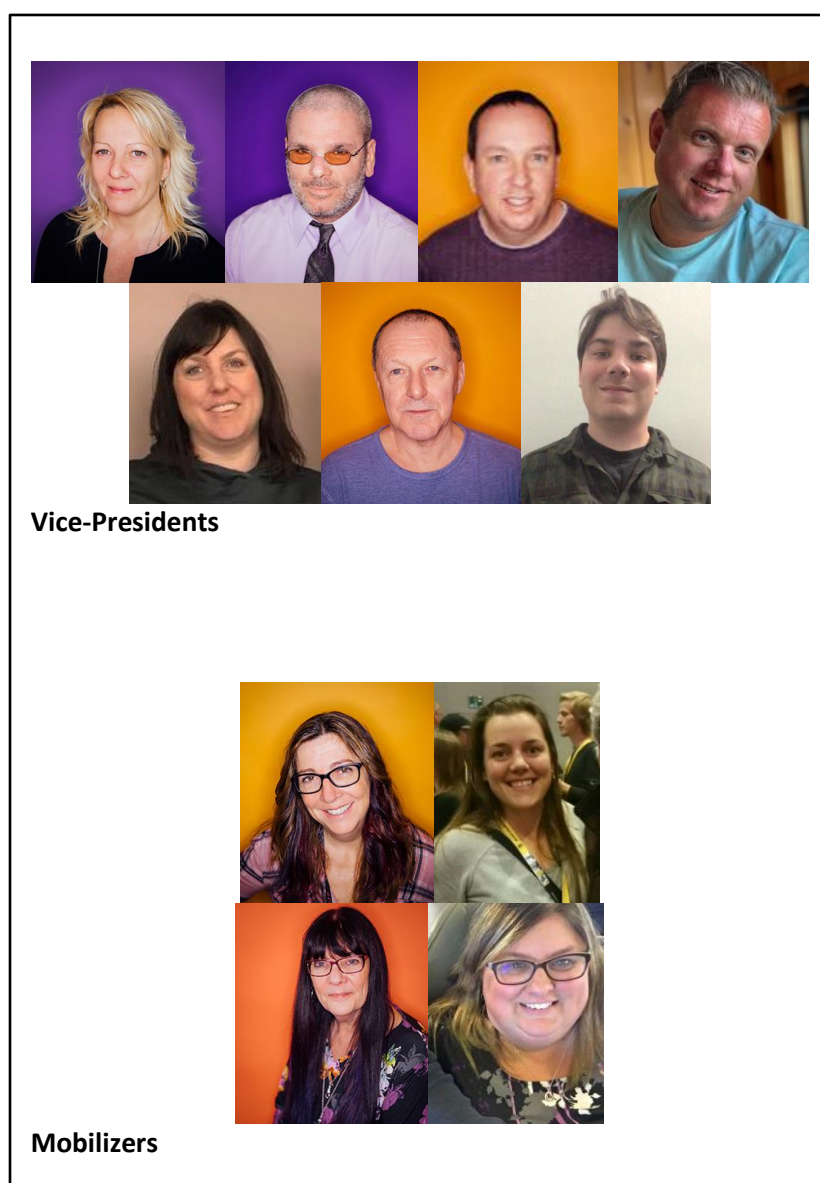

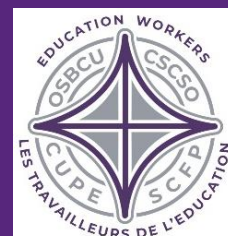

News

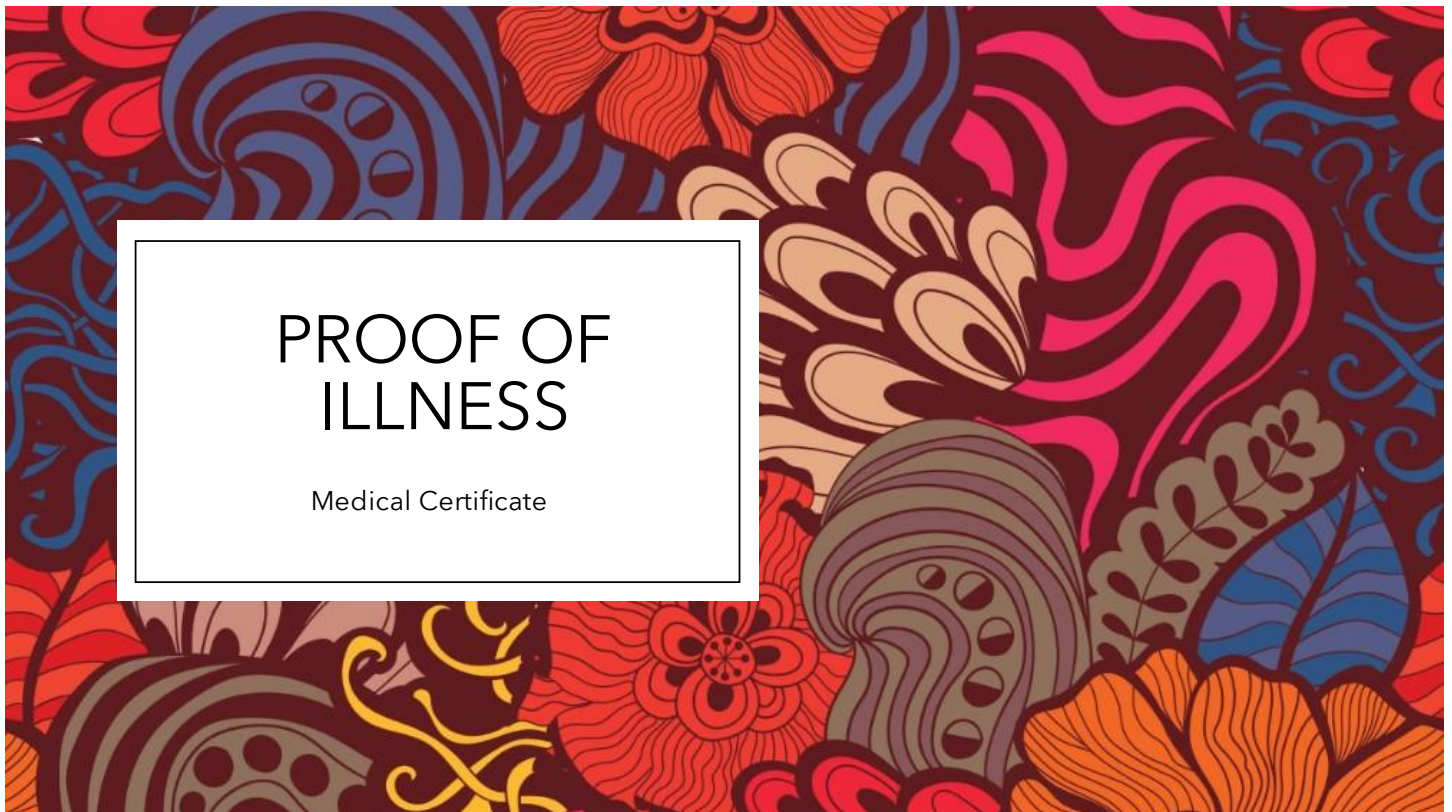
